NOTICE OF INTEREST IN PURCHASING WATER RIGHTS

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that Grantsville City is inviting offers from water right owners to sell water rights to Grantsville City (the "City"). Pursuant to the policy of the Utah Division of Water Rights, to be considered for purchase by the City, the water right must be within the Tooele Valley, generally West of Highway 36 and be available for use by the City. All persons or entities interested in selling water rights to the City shall submit either a written offer or a notice of interest to Tom Hammond, Grantsville City Finance Director at 429 East Main Street, Grantsville Utah 84029 on or before September 29, 2011 at 5:00 p.m. The offers or notices will be reviewed by the City Council at its October 5, 2011 meeting at 7:00 p.m.

Persons interested in submitting a written offer or notice to the City, should provide the following information:

- Seller's name, phone number and mailing address
- Water Right Number
- Number of acre feet offered
- Name of owner of water right if different from seller
- Current use(s) of water right
- Place of use of water right
- Point of diversion of water right
- Sales price (offers without a sales price will not be considered)

All purchases of water rights shall be structured to close at the time the State Engineer approves the transfer to the City for municipal use. Seller will be required to take all necessary steps and pay for the costs to convert water rights to municipal use diverted from designated city sources and also pay for a policy of title insurance. Seller will be required to pay for and use the City's designated water rights attorney and title company to complete the transaction. For more information contact the City Office at (435) 884-3411. Any commissions will be paid by seller.
