

**MINUTES OF A WORK MEETING OF THE GRANTSVILLE CITY COUNCIL
AND GRANTSVILLE IRRIGATION WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 28, 2001**

Mayor and Council Present: Council Members: Craig Anderson, Kevin Hall, and Justin Linares. Paul Rupp Council Elect.

Discussion of irrigated acre and the water requirement: 64% is considered the irrigated acre of lots ½ acre and above. Kevin asked those present if the Irrigation Company was OK with where the city is? Joe Peterson felt that the City should start there and then revisit the issues of irrigation of land over one acre. Ron Rydalch stated that any land larger than one-acre will probably using nozzle limits. Kevin stated that this is a beginning we will have to revisit the requirements as we go along and find the problems. The 7,000 square foot lot may be revisited sooner than later. Craig suggested that the Irrigation Company become more active in getting small lot subdivisions on their systems. Richard Anderson stated that the Irrigation Company is going to have to start considering the ½ share. Ron Rydalch stated that he would be OK with the ½ share if the water is metered. Kevin asked for a raise of hands to see if the majority is in line with this presented document. Majority of the Irrigation Company is for this starting document. Judd stated to those present that the City Council has come to this document after years of great pain and compromise.
