

**MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE GRANTSVILLE CITY
COUNCIL HELD WEDNESDAY, JUNE 12, 2002.**

Mayor and Council Present: Mayor Byron Anderson. Council Members: Craig Anderson, James Christensen, Kevin Hall, Justin Linares, and Paul Rupp.

Appointed officers and employees present: Wendy Palmer, City Recorder.

Citizens and Guests:

Recorder Palmer explained the final numbers for property tax and personal property tax. Recorder Palmer stated that she has worked through the numbers with Tooele County Treasurer Valerie Lee. The major change is the unattached personal property tax is considered a part of the General Property tax. Recorder Palmer amended the entries to reflect that change.

It was determined that since final project numbers are not available for major projects out of the capital improvement accounts and the Impact fee accounts that the budget would be amended at the time the projects are ready to bid.

Mayor and Council instructed Recorder Palmer to include cost of living increase to 2.9% for all employees effective July 1, 2002. Salary employees will be eligible for the salary step increases, which is equal to an additional 3% salary increase. Statutory Officer will receive 3% salary increases July 1, 2002. Mayors to receive a \$5000 annual salary increase. Council will receive 5.9% salary increase. Kevin to receive an additional \$50.00 monthly to cover cell phone costs to run the Public Work Department. Mayor to get salary survey numbers from HR Susan Gustin to verify Police Chiefs salary level.

Mayor asked Recorder Palmer to make \$10,000 available for the Main Street Improvement project.

CONSIDERATION OF SEASONAL EMPLOYEE: Kevin made the motion to approve one seasonal employee for summer. Justin seconded the motion. All voted in favor, motion carried.

There was some concerned expressed about the road standard required for John Conway at the Indian Hills Trailer Court Improvements at 520 W. Clark. Kevin stated that he would talk with the Zoning Administrator tomorrow.

Craig made the motion to adjourn at 10:10 p.m. Justin seconded the motion. All voted in favor, motion carried.
