

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL HELD
SEPTEMBER 24, 2003**

Mayor Anderson called the meeting to order immediately following the RDA Meeting at 7:50 p.m.

CONSIDERATION AND ADOPTION OF ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE WEST BENCH ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PLAN DATED AUGUST 15, 2003: James made the motion to adopt the West Bench Economic Development Plan Dated August 15, 2003. Kevin seconded the motion. All voted in favor, motion carried.

CONSIDERATION AND ADOPTION OF RESOLUTION ADOPTING ELECTRONIC MEETING PROCEDURES RESOLUTION: Kevin made the motion to adopt the electronic meeting procedures for the City Council. Paul seconded the motion. All voted in favor, motion carried.

OTHER BUSINESS: Mayor stated that Groen Brothers Aviation and the other industries out by I-80 would like to set up an improvement district and buy water wholesale from Grantsville City. The problem with that is they buy the water from us and then raise the price and sell it to others.

Kevin stated that the cowboys in our area have been asking him about what will happen to the open range grazing between the Wal-Mart and I-80. They are concerned about the truck traffic and the safety of their cows. It was suggested that they may have to fence the grazing property in.
