**MINUTES OF THE WORK MEETING OF THE GRANTSVILLE CITY COUNCIL,

**1. Review of the tentative 2013 – 2014 Budget.**

Mayor Marshall and the Councilmen were given a revised budget worksheet.

The Library section of the budget worksheet was discussed and reviewed. Changes were made as needed. The Library section tentative budget total was adjusted to \$190,500.

Mayor Marshall indicated the Planning and Zoning budget had already been discussed.

Chief Turner discussed the Police Department budget with Mayor Marshall and the Councilmen item by item. Mayor Marshall stated an error occurred on the salaries, benefits and health insurance. He explained the numbers presented were correct. Changes were made. The Police Department section tentative budget total was adjusted to \$1,388,000.

The Animal Control section of the budget worksheet was discussed and reviewed. The Animal Control tentative budget total was adjusted to \$71,150.

Fire Chief Bret Anderson discussed the Fire Department budget with Mayor Marshall and the Councilmen item by item. Changes were made as needed and the Fire Department section tentative budget total was adjusted to \$258,700.

Mayor Marshall asked to review the Donations section of the budget worksheet. The City received two requests for donations. One was received from the Children's Justice Center and another from the Grantsville High School Band. The City Council decided to review the Donations section of the budget at the next work meeting.
