**1. Discussion of awarding the landscaping contract.**

Information was provided for discussion of the possibility to contract the landscaping for the City parks, cemetery and other City owned properties. The Councilmen were given the amounts from the City maintenance crew. Mayor Marshall proposed hiring three individuals for summer help this year and then track the costs to maintain the landscaping of the City properties accurately. Councilman Colson reported he talked to the parks and rec director of Tooele who had subcontracted some of their landscaping work and it had been a very good decision. Councilman Colson suggested contracting for the park sites excluding the baseball/softball fields and the cemetery to see how it goes. The Council felt it would be good to try a few of the smaller parks to get an idea of how it might work. The City Council decided to issue an RFP to contract the landscaping of Academy Square, Hollywood Park, Lincoln Park and City Hall/ the Library. Attorney Linares was asked to work on the RFP and the Council scheduled a meeting to go over the RFP Friday, February 21<sup>st</sup> at 4:00 p.m.
