**MINUTES OF THE WORK MEETING OF THE GRANTSVILLE CITY COUNCIL, HELD ON MAY 17, 2017 AT THE GRANTSVILLE CITY HALL, 429 EAST MAIN STREET, GRANTSVILLE, UTAH. THE MEETING BEGAN AT 5:00 P.M.**

**1. Discussion of Budget.**

Finance Director, Sherrie Broadbent, provided information and options for the purchase of a new fire truck. The Council decided to put an RFP out for the fire truck with a disclosure added to clarify the request. The fire department budget was reviewed.

Mrs. Broadbent went over the police department budget. Chief Enslin presented information on three vehicles he would like to purchase to replace the Impalas. Mrs. Broadbent explained that she would like to purchase them and amend the current budget.

Next, Mrs. Broadbent, reported on the budget for the parks, community relations/human resources, and public works. The Council reviewed the requests for donations and agreed to donate \$1,500 to the Clark Historic Farm, \$1,100 to the Tooele Education Foundation, \$0 to The Johnson Hall Rehabilitation Coalition, \$1,500 to the Grantsville Volunteer Fire Auxiliary (if they receive their 501 (c)(3) designation), \$1,000 to Grantsville Junior High School, and \$400 to Down & Dirty Barrel Racing.
