**MINUTES OF THE WORK MEETING OF THE GRANTSVILLE CITY COUNCIL, HELD ON OCTOBER 17, 2017 AT THE GRANTSVILLE CITY HALL, 429 EAST MAIN STREET, GRANTSVILLE, UTAH. THE MEETING BEGAN AT 5:00 P.M.**

**1. Discussion on updating the Grantsville City Master/General Plan.**

Councilwoman Allen thanked Gary Pinkham from the Planning Commission for being present. Councilman Colson proposed they use this meeting to plan how to move forward. He suggested choosing three items that they would like to work on quickly for the Master Plan and decide if they are going to get some outside help to involve them immediately. Councilwoman Sparks felt they should form a committee not made up completely of City Council and Planning Commission Members, but have a combination of the two groups. Mr. Pinkham suggested they have a preliminary meeting to discuss the general concept of where we are, where we want to go, and how we are going to get there. He agreed, they need to discuss what the vision is for Grantsville. Mr. Pinkham stated they need to get public notice out as soon as possible requesting public input. He felt that in addition to the legal noticing, it should be added in with the Mayor's newsletter with a deadline of the 15<sup>th</sup> or 20<sup>th</sup> of November. The Mayor and Council felt they should specify what they need public input on so they do not get input on things that are not pertinent.

Councilwoman Allen thought if there is merit in having an outside consultant, then they could provide guidance on determining priorities and identify areas to work on. Mr. Pinkham felt they need to determine the vision for Grantsville. Those present discussed planning how to update the general plan and the purpose of the moratorium.

It was decided that all Council and Commission Members would get a copy of the General Plan electronically and paper and they would meet on November 9<sup>th</sup> prior to the Planning Commission Meeting.
