**MINUTES OF THE WORK MEETING OF THE GRANTSVILLE CITY COUNCIL, HELD ON MAY 16, 2018 AT THE GRANTSVILLE CITY HALL, 429 EAST MAIN STREET, GRANTSVILLE, UTAH. THE MEETING BEGAN AT 5:30 P.M.**

**1. Discussion of budget.**

Finance Director, Sherrie Broadbent, reviewed the expenses. She explained the budget and the changes proposed for the following departments: Planning & Zoning, Police, and Fire.

Councilman Tripp arrived at the meeting at 5:40 p.m.

Mrs. Broadbent went over the budget for the Inspection and Animal Control Departments. She then reviewed the budget for streets, Class "C" Roads, Parks and Recreation, Community Relations/Human Res., and Cemetery. She provided the donation requests and the Council discussed the requests.

Mayor Marshall suggested purchasing a speaker system that could be checked out by the Tooele County 4-H Club and others. The Council Members thought that would be a good idea. The Council decided to donate to the Grantsville Senior Citizen Board (\$500), Grantsville Fire Auxiliary (\$1,500), Friends of the Clark Farm (\$1,500), Grantsville Performing Arts Council (\$1,500), and L.A.R.A. (\$500).

Mrs. Broadbent asked the Council if the certified tax rate comes in and we have additional funds available, what they would like to use those for. They felt the top priority is to hire a crossing guard to work at Grantsville Elementary School on Park Street at Apple Street.

Councilwoman Sparks asked about the information provided about the Wootton House.
