Half the cost of the trees is being paid for by the homeowner and half by the City of Grantsville! **Additional trees** for your yard may be purchased at full cost.

*Suggestion: Plant two or more of the same species in front of your home for balance.*

- \_\_\_\_\_ Homestead Elm- Height: 55' Spread: 35' - Oval/Arching - Growth Rate: Fast- Adapts to high PH soils.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Fruitless Mulberry- (30'-50') Good desert tree , large leaves, broad shade, fast growing. Excellent choice.
- \_\_\_\_\_ London Plane- Large (70'-90') On entrance road to South Willow Estates, fast growing with plenty of water.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Green Ash- (50') "Autumn Purple"- Oval shape, along streets in Palomino Ranch subdivision, very hardy, fast.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Crab Apple- (18') "Indian Magic"- Draped in stunning clusters of fragrant fuchsia flowers. Good for our soils.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Linden- (40') Quality tree, good oval shape, fragrant little flower in spring, medium growth rate. Excellent here.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Honey Locust- (30'-50') "Imperial" fast-growing- Tolerant of alkaline soils. Graceful, thornless.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Canada Red- (25'-35') - Early green leaves turn dark purple. Showy flowers, strong, reliable tree.
