Welcome to our Celebration! Please complete and return the bottom portion of this official entry form to Grantsville City Hall at 429 East Main Street by June 30th to guarantee your position in the parade lineup. Late entries are not guaranteed a position in the parade lineup or may be placed at the end of the parade.

Awards and Prizes:

All entries will be judged and prizes will be awarded based on the following criteria:

- Best In Show (Top Award) Most Creative Most Patriotic
Most Original Best Theme Best Business

Awards and prizes will be announced in the August Mayor's Newsletter. Your float number given to you MUST be placed on your float and is for contest purposes only. It is NOT your number for the parade line-up.

Safety Rules and Guidelines:

- 1. Parade officials will inspect all entries and reserve the right to eliminate any entry.
2. The parade will start at City Hall at 11:00 a.m. on Tuesday, July 4, 2017. Parade will travel west on Main Street to Center Street then south on Center Street to Cherry Street then east on Cherry Street to the City Park.
3. Main Street will shut down at 10:30 a.m. Line-up will begin at City Hall. Staging areas will be at the Library, City Hall, and run east on Main Street to Matthews Lane. Entire group must know where they have been assigned for their staging area. Line-up will start 10:00 a.m. and parade will start at 11:00 a.m.
4. Changes in the parade line-up will be at the sole discretion of the parade officials.
5. Entries with children under the age of 14 must have one (1) adult per five (5) children.
6. Once your entry has started along the parade route, no one may board your float.
7. Your entry may not exit the parade route before the end of the parade.
8. Participants are not allowed to spray water, throw water balloons at spectators or engage in any other activities involving water along the parade route.
9. Participant's candy and advertising materials must hit the ground in front of spectators and not be thrown into the crowd.
10. Any dancing group choosing to dance in the parade must be moving with the parade at all times.
