

Erda Way/SR-138 Closure Saturday, Sept. 7

The following are planned activities for the coming week. Please note that due to weather conditions, emergency situations or equipment/supply issues, schedules are subject to change.

Saturday, Sept. 7: Crews will apply a micro-seal surface (gravel and oil slurry) to the newly realigned SR-138/Erda Way intersection and immediate vicinity to protect the roadway from weather and extend pavement life. To accommodate the work, Erda Way will be closed at SR-138 on Saturday from approximately 6 a.m. to 3 p.m. Motorists may use SR-112 or Sheep Lane as alternate routes during the closure. Alternating one-way flagging operations will also be in effect during daylight hours on SR-138 near the intersection and moderate delays are expected throughout the day on Saturday.

Roadway shoulder work is expected to continue through the week of Sept. 9. Intermittent one-way flagging operations on SR-138 may be necessary to accommodate this work, with minimal travel delays expected.

Project Information

The Utah Department of Transportation (UDOT) has realigned the intersection of SR-138 and Erda Way east of Grantsville. The project realigned Erda Way from its former skewed configuration to a perpendicular (90-degree) alignment to SR-138 to improve motorist sight distance and safety. Project completion is expected by late September 2013.
