Bulk garbage is only picked up once a month for residents. The Monday it's collected, depends on your regular garbage collection day; if your garbage is collected Monday or Tuesday, your bulk waste will be picked up on the 2nd Monday of the month. If your garbage is collected on Wednesday or Thursday, your bulk waste day is the 4th Monday of the month.

The Maintenance Department does a great job plowing the snow from our streets. Let's all make their job a little easier by not parking on the street or putting bulk trash out too early.
