- **Grantsville City Offices will be closed January 1st and January 15th.**
- **The Justice Court and the Police Department have moved into their new offices at 50 N. Bowery Street.**
- **The Dedication and Open House of the new Justice Center will be January 11th at 6:00 pm.**

The Grantsville City Council passed an ordinance on Nov 15th, 2017 that prohibits the distribution of commercial handbills (this includes the green bags of advertising materials) that are thrown onto lawns, driveways, sidewalks without the consent of the property owner. It also includes commercial handbills placed on vehicles. A violation of this ordinance shall be an infraction and will be enforceable to the city's littering ordinance. To read the entire ordinance, you may obtain a copy at city hall.

With the holidays coming to a close, we all have a lot of extra "stuff" that we need to get rid of. Please do not put bulk garbage in front of your yard until your scheduled pick up day.

Bulk garbage on the side of the road for days and weeks, before pick up day, has become a problem and an eye sore. If this continues, we may lose our privilege of having bulk pick up. Please be respectful of your neighbors and other citizens by not putting your bulk trash out early.

A reminder that business licenses were due on Dec. 31st. Those who do not renew their licenses by the end of January, will see their license fee double.

Renewal fees can be paid on-line at www.xpressbillpay.com, or by phone at 884-4603 or coming into city hall at 429 E. Main Street.

Dog licenses will be coming due on March 31st. The city will host a clinic where you will be able to get required vaccinations and licenses. Day and time will be posted at a later date.

Winter is here and driving in the snow can be dangerous. Here are some driving tips if you absolutely have to be out in the snow.

- Accelerate and decelerate slowly.
- Drive slowly.
- Know your brakes.
- Don't stop if you can avoid it.
- Don't power up hills.
- Don't stop going up a hill.
- Stay home if you do not need to be driving in inclement weather.

As the snow comes, please be sure to remove the snow from your sidewalks to allow those on foot an easier trail to get where they are headed. It is a good time to go the extra mile and give service to your neighbors who are in need of help, particularly those who are homebound, by removing the snow from their sidewalks too.

The Maintenance Department does a great job plowing the snow from our streets. Let's all make their job a little easier by not parking on the street or putting bulk trash out too early.
