Grantsville City will hold a municipal election to elect one (1) Mayor and two (2) City Council positions, all four years terms. Qualified candidates may file a Declaration of Candidacy form. The filing is to be done in person with the City Recorder at Grantsville City Hall, 429 E. Main St., Grantsville, Utah. **The filing period is from June 1, 2017 to June 7, 2017 during regular business office hours and not later than 5:00 p.m. on the last day of filing.** All candidates for election are subject to financial disclosure requirements. Qualifications for a candidate are: (1) Be a United States citizen at the time of filing; (2) Be a registered voter of the municipality; (3) Be a resident of the municipality or a resident of the recent annexed area for a period of 12 consecutive months immediately preceding the date of the election.
