New State Regulations for Residential Open Burning have been issued by the Division of Air Quality (DAQ) to regulate open burning activities to minimize and ensure that the National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS) are met. Applicants statewide are required to complete the open burn permit application and receive an open burn permit by contacting DAQ at (801) 536-4000 or visiting [www.airquality.utah.gov](http://www.airquality.utah.gov). Due to these new state regulations, open burn permits can no longer be obtained through Grantsville City Hall.
