New State Regulations for Residential Open Burning have been issued by the Division of Air Quality (DAQ) to regulate open burning activities to minimize and ensure that the National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS) are met. Applicants statewide are required to complete the open burn permit application and receive an open burn permit by contacting DAQ at (801) 536-4000 or visiting [www.airquality.utah.gov](http://www.airquality.utah.gov). Due to these new state regulations, open burn permits can no longer be obtained through Grantsville City nor the Fire Department.

The Tooele County Assessor's office is currently conducting a detailed review in Grantsville for the 2015 tax year. This is a routine analysis of each parcel as required by the Utah State Tax Commission. Over the course of the year all property owners should receive a mail survey. All properties will be visited briefly by a contracted data collector or staff member. The survey and visit are an opportunity to verify and/or correct information needed to generate a reliable appraisal for 2015's property tax valuation. Data collectors should knock and identify themselves with a county-issued ID. They will take a few pictures, ask a couple of questions and, if needed, take a few measurements. The new appraised value will not be completed until May of 2015. Please fill out the mail survey and return it promptly. If you have any questions or concerns, please call (435) 843-3110 ext. 2.
