Dog licenses will expire on March 31, 2015. The Grantsville Police Department along with the FFA will be holding a Rabies and Dog License Clinic on Thursday, March 5th from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. at the Fire Station. Fees will be as follows: Vaccinations - adult dog combo (\$17), puppy combo (\$18), dog rabies (\$12), cat combo (\$12), cat leukemia (\$16) and cat rabies (\$12); dog licensing - non-spayed (\$25) and with certificate of spay (\$15). A 30-day grace period will be given to renew your license. If you have not renewed your dog license by April 30, 2015 your fees will double! Grantsville City is in the process of formulating its 2015-2016 budget, which begins on July 1, 2015. With limited revenues and pursuant to the provisions of the Utah Code, the City is requiring any interested person or organization to submit applications for funding (donations) for the 2015-2016 fiscal year to the City prior to April 24, 2015 at 5:00 p.m. All requests for funding must be in writing and shall include the amount requested, the proposed use of the funds and a detailed explanation of the benefit the City will receive in return for the donation. The City will prioritize the funding requests and include those that are approved in the proposed budget. Requests should be submitted to Sherrie Broadbent, Finance Director, at 429 East Main Street, Grantsville, Utah 84029 prior to the deadline. Grantsville City will not fund any requests for donations for the 2015-2016 fiscal year unless an application is submitted as required above.
