Rocky Mountain Power is in the process of designing a job to improve power reliability in the Grantsville area. They will be increasing the size of wire on Main Street from 432 East Main Street to 791 East Main Street. Once this project is complete we are expecting to see reduced power interruptions as well as better power quality in Grantsville. Rocky Mountain Power's projected date for completion of this project is December 30th, 2013. They will attempt to do the majority of the work while keeping the main line energized in order to keep the power interruptions at a minimum. Rocky Mountain Power will need to significantly trim or even remove several trees. Homeowners between 432 East Main and 791 East Main will be contacted by representatives of Rocky Mountain Power prior to any work done so that any questions or concerns may be addressed.

A Halloween Parade will be held on Wednesday, October 30th. The parade will begin at 4:30 p.m. at Grantsville Elementary School and travel south on Center Street to Durfee Street, east on Durfee Street to Hale Street, then south on Hale Street to Diamond Jane's Assisted Living Center. Parents are encouraged to walk with their children.

This year's Santa and Light Parade will be held on Saturday, November 30th at 5:30 p.m. The parade will start at City Hall and travel along Main Street to the Fire Station. Santa will be staying at the Fire Station after the parade for the children to give him their wish lists. Start decorating your vehicle, trailer, float, or whatever you wish to put in the parade with your amazing lighting designs. Prizes will be given for the best lighting features and design. 
