HOME Rehabilitation Program

Need to make home improvements? The Housing Authority of Utah County offers low interest rehabilitation loans to qualified homeowners. The primary purpose of this program / loan is to help citizens live in safe and adequate housing. Loans can be used for roofing, plumbing, electrical, energy improvements, and code violations. Loans are available for Utah, Wasatch, Summit and Tooele Counties. Weatherization Program

This program is designed for low income families who need to have their homes weatherized. This program is multi-faceted in that it helps clients with energy education, practical experience, indoor air quality, combustion safety, increased energy efficiency, and the physical comforts of a fully weatherized home. Weatherization repairs may include wall, floor, ceiling and duct insulation; windows, caulking, door repair or replacement, weather-stripping, furnace tune-up and repairs or replacement, and carbon monoxide testing.
