## GRANTSVILLE CITY ORDINANCE NO. 2021-32

## AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE COMPENSATION FOR ELECTIVE OFFICERS OF GRANTSVILLE CITY, UTAH FOR THE 2021 - 2022 FISCAL YEAR.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GRANTSVILLE CITY COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION ONE: PURPOSE.** This Ordinance is for the purpose of fixing the compensation of the elective officers of Grantsville City, commencing in the City's 2021-2022 fiscal year, pursuant to the requirements of Utah Code Annotated § 10-3-818 (2010).

**SECTION TWO: COMPENSATION ESTABLISHED.** The elective officers of Grantsville City, Utah shall receive the following compensation commencing in the City's 2021-2022 fiscal year.

Mayor	\$91,624.00	\$95,288.96

The Mayor shall also be entitled to all of the fringe benefits afforded other City employees and if the Mayor elects to withdraw, or not participate in the State Retirement program, said person shall be entitled to a contribution by the City to an approved State 401(k) or similar program in the sum of 18.47% of their regular salary. The City Council members are not entitled to fringe benefits other than the compensation as stated on page one above.

SECTION THREE: EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect as of 12:00 a.m. on July 1, 2021 and the bi-weekly compensation amounts stated above shall be paid out starting with the regular July 2, 2021 payday and shall continue every two weeks thereafter unless amended by an Ordinance of the City Council and provided that prior to the effective date a short summary of this ordinance has been published in a newspaper of general circulation summary of this ordinance has been published in a newspaper of general circulation within Grantsville City, as provided for by law.
